**WHY?** – Knox County Public and UT-Knoxville (including Education Department)

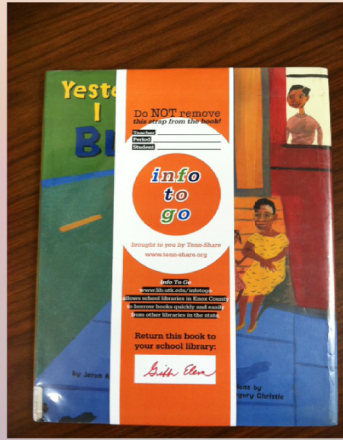
**HOW?** – Partnership, “It's just a nice little program that sits off on the side.”

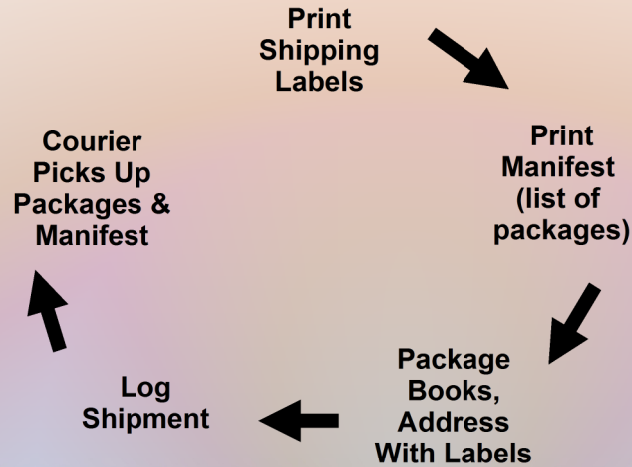
