WOMS invited community members and school leaders to read to our English Language Arts students in grades sixth, seventh and eighth.

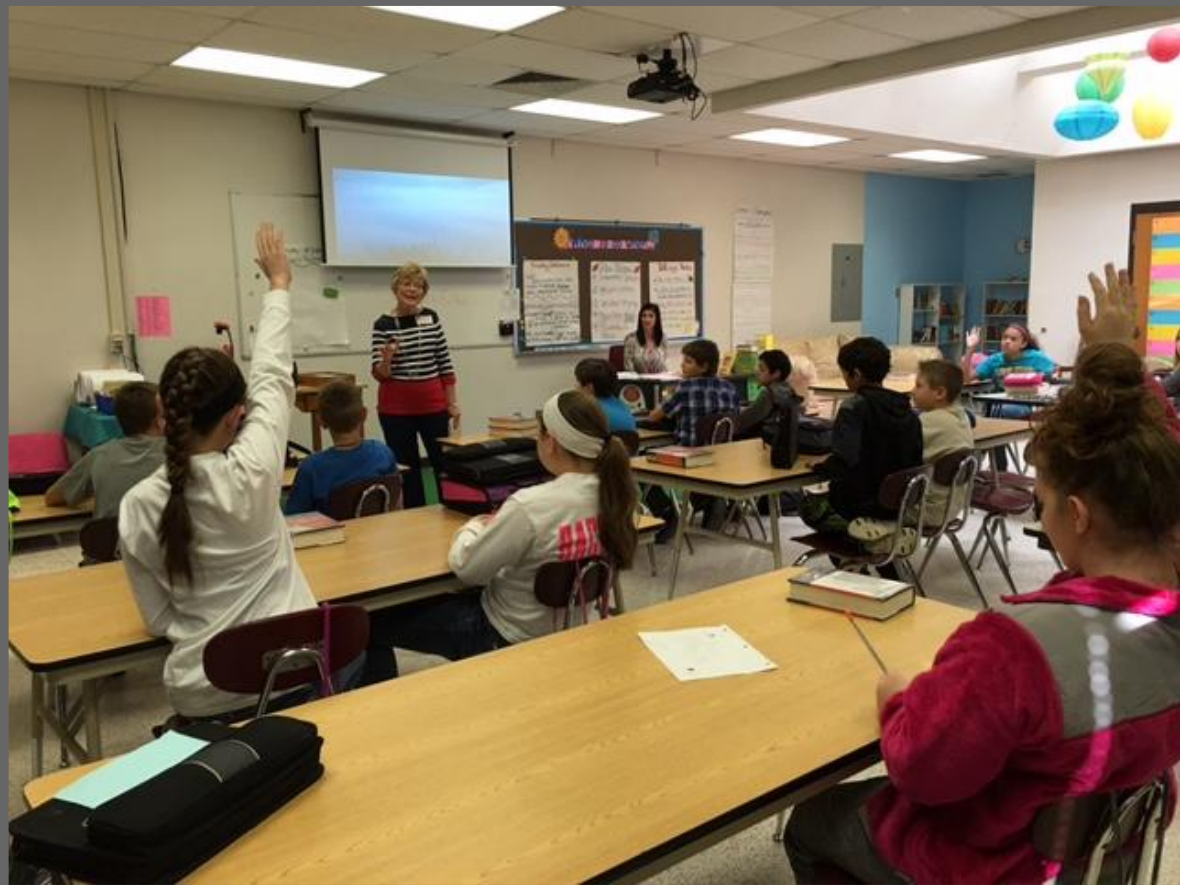
